

Pat Murton Educational Fund

Purpose:

This memorial fund is established to provide Schuss Mountain patrollers with funding to register for NSP approved education programs who otherwise may not attend due to the cost, and for those identified by the leadership to attend for the mutual benefit of the patrol.

Process:

- The request can be initiated by the patrol leadership (PD/APD) or any patroller.
- Application is submitted to the Patrol Director
- The patroller will be reimbursed upon successful course completion for a previously agreed upon amount based upon financial need
- Covered costs
 - Registration
 - Required course materials
- List of qualifying courses may be modified as necessary

Management of the Fund:

The fund will be managed by the Patrol Director, Treasurer and a member of the Murton family who are responsible for approving all applications.
